Marina rules

- All vessels must be insured with full comprehensive cover or Third Party with salvage and a copy provided to the marina.
- All external contractors must sign into the marina office and pay the annual or per visit contractor fee.
- The marina is a no wash zone.
- All vessels are to be kept in a seaworthy condition. Vessels and surrounding areas are to be kept clean and tidy including hoses, power leads, no tenders in the water and no hazardous materials.
- We are a Certified Clean Marina, please ensure waste is removed or disposed of correctly and waste facilities provided are used appropriately.
- No fishing or use of crab traps are permitted on the marina, including from vessels while in the marina.
- All refuelling is to be performed at the fuel wharf, this includes the use of jerry cans.

Key Considerations

- Use environmentally sustainable cleaning products available in the chandlery.
- Use the pump out facilities located on the fuel wharf for sewage discharge.
- Oily Bilge water is not to be discharged from the vessel. Absorbent pads and spill equipment is available in the chandlery. Contact marina office for correct extraction and disposal.
- Do not fuel vessels up at the berth, make use of the safety equipment and safe practices at the fuel wharf.
- Make use of waste disposal facilities provided by the Marina.
- Fishing and the use of crab traps etc is not allowed on the marina.
